SUBJECT: <u>SUMMER SCHOOL</u>

Elementary Summer School was offered for pre-kindergarten through fourth grade students at Whitley Road Elementary School from June 7 through July 2, 2004. Debbie Word served as elementary summer school principal.

Attendance at each grade level is listed below:

Pre-kindergarten	21 students
Kindergarten	107 students
First Grade	108 students
Second Grade	50 students
Third Grade	23 students
Fourth Grade	23 students

Total number of students attended: 332

Summer school activities concentrated on reading improvement in grades 1-4, and early literacy skills in pre-kindergarten and kindergarten. Math concepts were reinforced through problem solving and a review of critical math concepts. An ending assessment was administered to each student in attendance. A final grade report for each student was forwarded to all home campuses for Student Assistance Services (SAS) Committee decisions regarding grade advancement.

Limited English Proficient (LEP) students in pre-kindergarten and kindergarten were provided extended day summer school services in accordance with Texas statute. The focus of the activities during this extended time was language acquisition and development of English proficiencies. A total of 62 LEP students attended the extended summer school session; 21 pre-kindergarten students and 41 kindergarten students.

Students in grade 5-6 attended summer school at South Keller Intermediate School. Summer school for these students began June 7, 2004 and continued through July 2, 2004. Amy Burkman served as intermediate summer school principal. 44 fifth grade students and 48 sixth grade students attended summer school at South Keller Intermediate. Amy Burkman served as intermediate summer school principal and was assisted by Laura McSkimming who was completing her administrative internship with Texas Woman's University.

Students in grade 7-8 attended summer school at Keller Middle School from June 3 – July 1, 2004. Rachel Jacobs, certified administrator and current teacher at FRHS served as Summer School Principal.

Students in grade 9-12 attended summer school at Keller High School. Keller High Assistant Principal Rick Burks served as Summer School Principal from June 1, 2004 through July 1, 2004.
