BBB	Dates for elections of each Board position are updated.
BQA	Campus Committee member terms of service will not be limited. Previously the members were limited to two one-year terms.
BQB	The term designee is eliminated. Communication strategies for the Campus Committee lies within the responsibilities of the principal.
DBA	Statement regarding state teacher certification and the DOI plan is eliminated. Since this is addressed in the District DOI plan it is not necessary to also have it in policy.
DC	The policy revision would allow the Superintendent to have final authority to employee contracted personnel from March1 – August 31.
DCA	Deletion of the policy regarding the mandatory probationary contract As this is addressed in the district DOI plan.
DCB	Removal of the portion of this policy that states that SBEC certification is not required for the business manager and technology director. It is unnecessary to have this in policy.
DCE	The policy is added regarding non-Chapter 21 contracts. The policy states that non-Chapter 21 contracts will be provided for positions that are included on a list provided by the board and the contracts are not subject to the guidelines in Chapter 21 of the education code.
DEA	The portion of this policy that included premium pay during disasters is removed.
DEAB	Definition of the work week is changed to beginning at 12:00 am Sunday until 11:59 pm Saturday.
DEC	Local leave earned from the current school year is all that can be donated to the sick leave pool. Reimbursement of days is changed to a maximum of 100 from the previous maximum of 75.
DED	Policy is added regarding vacation days for twelve-month employees.
DK	Statement is deleted regarding campus assignments as it is addressed in the District's DOI plan.
DP	Adjustment due to the exemption from 80/20 being added to the DOI plan.

School start and end date is removed from policy as this in the DOI plan.
Policy for class size ratio is deleted as this is addressed in the DOI plan.
Adds statement that campus transfers will be able to continue in the District GT program.
Statement is added regarding compliance with special programs.
Rearranges wording that states academic mastery is based on a 100 scale.
Petitions for credit must be filed by the last day of class. Removes ten days after class.
Removes wording in the nutrition guidelines. Adds that the assistant superintendent for curriculum oversees the implementation of SHAC.
Wording regarding directory information is updated.
Removes policy regarding student travel as this is covered in administrative regulations.
Deletes the term "designee" from this policy regarding distribution of non-school literature.
Deletes the term "designee" from this policy regarding use of school Facilities for non-school purposes.
Eliminates the statement that corporal punishment may only be administered by an employee of the same sex as a student.
Deletes the policy referring to news releases during a crisis. This Is addressed in the District safety plan.
