I. MEETING CALLED TO ORDER: Board President Lupita Fuentes called the meeting to order at 6:04 PM.

II. BOARD WORKSHOP: (No action will be taken by the Board at the workshop.)

- 1. Team of Eight Workshop presented by Education Service Center Region 20 Consultants.
- 2. Senate Bill 1566 Workshop presented by Education Service Center Region 20 Consultants.

Education Service Center Region 20 Consultants Dee Ann Drummond and Ed Vara addressed the Board of Trustees and Superintendent. The topic of this annual training was "Your Roll as a Board." This included two required trainings; *The Team of Eight and the new Legislative Update SB 1566. With SB 1566 the School Boards' primary responsibilities is the Oversight of Student Achievement.* This has always been what the Board has been here for, but now it has been put into law. Also, put into the SB1566, is a new requirement for training, which is what is taking place now and the discussion was evaluating, and improving student outcomes as required by SB1566. Assessed at this workshop were the districts (EPISD & CISD) Goals, and each districts TAPR Report. A power point presentation that included both topics was

discussed and collaboration on the topics amongst each other was eventful. The main discussion of the training was *Student outcomes don't change until adult behaviors change*... and what the consultants asked the Board Members to ask themselves was "which adults behavior has to change first?" examples led to parents, teachers, campus leadership, high expectations from parents and students, the Board, coaches, mentors... Board Members addressed their thoughts of *Student outcomes don't* change *until adult behavior change*.

The TAPR Report was discussed and board members were asked if they knew what the report identifies and what explanation could they offer to a parent/citizen who addresses them on how to read the report? Another question to the Board was "Is there School Choice in the district?" The answer was yes...They (parents-students) choose where to live to attend the school they prefer, some districts also allow students to choose teachers, etc. This is where they discussed Student Outcomes, which is the main reason everyone here is here. Students are the reason... it is not about sports, it is not about the buildings, not about the turf to use in the field, etc., yes they are part of the district but it is part of doing business. The central mission at board meetings is the education of the kids and when they graduate they will be contributing members of the community. Therefore the focus of the workshop consisted on the *Inputs, Outputs and Outcomes of the Students*. Evaluating & Improving Student Outcomes is progress, monitoring, accountability, implementation, vision and values of their community, School Board behaviors impact student outcomes, also student Outcome Goal is SMART (specific, measurable, attainable, results-focused, time-bound) which describes what students know or are able to do; a student outcome made SMART. This outcome goal must have a baseline, target, deadline population, and must challenge the organization and require adult behavior change.

Consultants concluded the training with Q & A by/from the Board both Eagle Pass ISD & Carrizo Springs ISD as the illustration was to the fullest satisfaction on both topics.

Before adjournment, Board President and Superintendent thanked Carrizo Springs ISD Board of Trustees for their attendance to the workshop with Eagle Pass ISD.
