Closing on Donated CTC Site

BACKGROUND/CONSIDERATIONS:

During its February 25 regular meeting, the Board accepted the donation of a building and site for the District's new Career and Technology Center (CTC). The site is within district boundaries at the corner of Zero and Painter. As previously discussed, the CTC will provide focused education and training in specialty areas within the STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math) disciplines. In terms of its value, this contribution is an investment in the CTC that far exceeds the \$3 million budgeted for site acquisition as part of the Vision 2023 Capital Improvement Plan.

A resolution approved by the Board is required to complete the process of closing on the property.

RECOMMENDATION:
