#### **PACE Outreach**

We are beginning to look at PACE advertising plans for the 2024-25 school year. Our goal is to capture the momentum we currently see with increased enrollment.

The ALC hosted a meet and greet with all PACE teachers and staff during the PACE inservice on November 8. Families came in for pizza, crafts, and a chance to talk to the superintendent, counselor, special education teacher, principal, and all teachers.

Additionally, families in Juneau have the opportunity to meet for an art class on Friday, November 17. This is the first such activity for PACE in Juneau.

### **PACE Staffing**

We have temporarily paused our search for an administrative assistant in Anchorage. We hope to redefine our goals with this position and post in the new year.

### **School Improvement**

PACE met in Anchorage for inservice November 7-8. We spent time reworking major A3 goals, the framework for our school improvement. The two main goals remain the same, but objectives within each goal have been revised to best meet our interests moving forward. An updated draft of the A3 reflecting this work will be included in the December packet.

Within the A3 work, PACE focused on our MTSS plan, part of both school and district-wide goals. We continue to look at new and/or better ways to meet the needs of our struggling students and families. All staff renewed their CPR and First Aid certifications as well.
