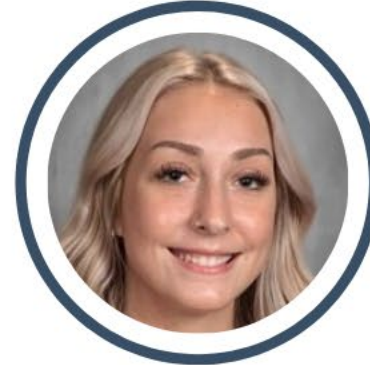

# Does good design matter?

- Your surroundings impact how you act, feel, think, behave, work, eat, sleep
- Surrounding yourself within a successfully designed environment is just like surrounding yourself with influential people. They make an impact.
- A good design will help you be organized, function and perform at your best.
- You may not notice a GOOD design at first because it serves your needs well.
  - Everything runs smoothly.
  - You feel happier.
- But you will notice a BAD design very easily
  - Everyday life becomes harder
  - Less organized
  - More stress

## Does good design have an impact?

- If a space isn't designed well, the people using the space won't perform well.
- Different colors even have a psychological impact on people.
  - **PINK**: delicate, subtle, reduces anger, playful, wonder, soft
  - **RED**: stimulating, exciting, passionate, energy, confidence, motivation
  - **ORANGE**: health, enthusiasm, creativity, caution, high energy, awareness, fun
  - **YELLOW**: friendly, happy, energized, sympathy, safety
  - **GREEN**: nature, serenity, friendliness, intellectual, balance, health, calming, relaxing
  - **BLUE**: soothing, trusting, relaxing, tranquil, insight, spiritual, peaceful
  - **PURPLE**: dramatic, ambitious, mysterious, awareness, creative, royal, bravery, value, magical
  - **BLACK**: sophisticated, formal, authority, wisdom, elegance, power, strong, classic
  - **WHITE**: pure, fresh, peaceful, clean, crisp, focus, innocence, empowering
  - **GRAY**: conservative, dignified, calm, neutral, serious, reasonable, formal

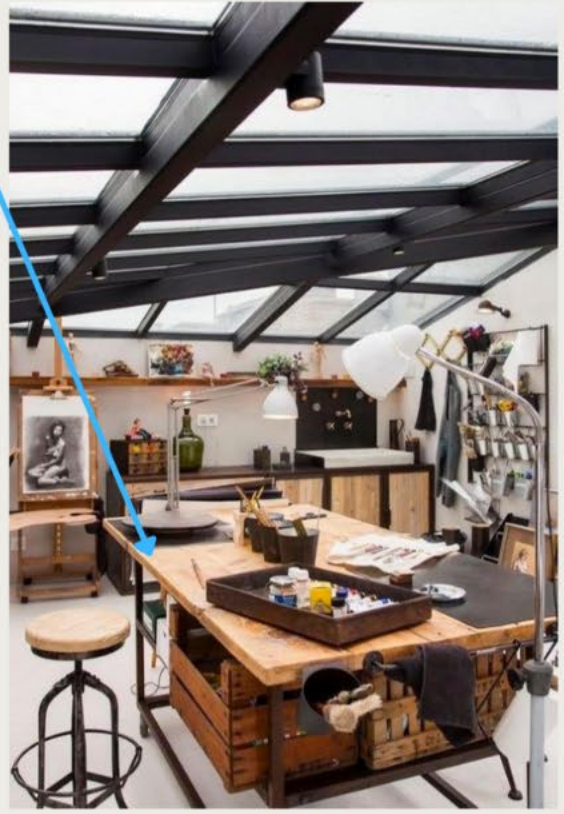
