Developing Awareness of Similarities and Differences between Spanish and English

Developing Literacy in Spanish

- Applying the principles of effective instruction for language learners to develop vocabulary, grammar, and comprehension in Spanish
- Targeting vocabulary instruction and oral language development using interactive teacher read-alouds, songs, and poems
- Promoting Spanish language and literacy development in the content areas
- Providing opportunities for meaningful language use through student interaction
- Identifying strategies to promote students' use of Spanish
- Using guided reading lessons to teach students strategies for using meaning, structure and visual information when they read
- Instructing writing and reading comprehension strategies in Spanish
