Minutes of Regular Meeting, August 26, 2024

The Board of Trustees Grapevine-Colleyville ISD

A Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees of Grapevine-Colleyville ISD was held August 26, 2024, at 5:30 p.m. at the Administration Building, 3051 Ira E. Woods Ave., Grapevine, TX 76051.

I. <u>OPEN SESSION - CALL TO ORDER</u> II. <u>REGULAR SESSION</u>

President Shannon Braun called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

GCISD Trustees Present: Shannon Braun, Mary Humphrey, Kathy Florence Spradley, Dalia Begin, Tammy Nakamura, A.J. Pontillo, and Dianna Sager.

GCISD Trustees Absent: None.

School Officials Present: Superintendent Dr. Brad Schnautz, Chief Operations Officer Paula Barbaroux, Chief Academic Officer Dr. Shiela Shiver, Chief Technology Officer Kyle Berger, Chief of Schools Dr. Holly Ray, Chief Financial Officer Derick Sibley, and Chief Human Resources Officer Kelly Mires.

III. MOMENT OF SILENCE & PLEDGES OF ALLEGIANCE

The Board and Administration paused for a moment of silence. Trustee A.J. Pontillo led the pledges to the U.S. Texas flags.

IV. ANNOUNCEMENTS

Trustee A.J. Pontillo shared that last week, GCISD held its first of six Gold Card sessions scheduled for the year. The Gold Card program is for GCISD residents who are 65 years or older, and members receive free general admission to GCISD events after attending the informational session.

Trustee Dalia Begin shared that GCISD's counseling team is holding parent preview sessions for the SOS Signs of Suicide Prevention Program which is offered for secondary students grades 6-12. The parent previews will be held on August 28 at 10:00 a.m. and at 6:00 p.m. at the GCISD Administration Building. Details about the presentations will be in campus e-newsletters.

Trustee Mary Humphrey shared that Colleyville Heritage High School Head Golf Coach Ryan Parker was named the 2023-2024 North Texas High School Girls Golf Coach of the Year by the North Texas High School Golf Coaches Association.

Superintendent Dr. Schnautz shared that GCISD employees were surprised with the news at Convocation that every full-time employee would receive a one-time payment of \$500 and every

part-time employee would receive a one-time payment of \$250 for their commitment to the 2024-2025 school year.

President Shannon Braun shared that GCISD's Financial Services has received the top rating of "A" for Superior Achievement in the Financial Integrity Rating System of Texas. GCISD has received the award every year since it was first developed by TEA in 1999.

Vice President Kathy Spradley shared that the Bransford Elementary staff room received a makeover thanks to the school's Dad's Club. She thanked the Bransford dads, families and local businesses that pitched in to transform this room into a beautiful space for staff. She also thanked Todd Raymond for opening MPS to seniors to take photos.

Trustee Dianna Sager shared that Bear Creek Elementary created a Goldilocks-themed area in the school's vestibule, thanks to donations from the Graceful Buys resale store and administrative team members. Since BCES is a No Excuses University School, visitors will find a story about the bears visiting Goldilocks' college living room, which resembles the furniture.

Trustee Tammy Nakamura shared the first home football game is August 30 for Colleyville Heritage High School and September 6 for Grapevine High School. Season tickets can be purchased online.

VI. PRESIDENT'S REPORT

President Shannon Braun shared information about the VATRE.

- The Board called for a November Voter-Approved Tax Ratification Election (VATRE) at the August 12 Special Meeting. This election had to be called at a special meeting because the deadline to call the election was August 19 and VATREs can only be placed on the November ballot in Texas.
- This election calls for a three-cent increase on the Maintenance & Operations tax rate.
- The Board lowered the Interest & Sinking (or debt service) tax rate that pays for bonds, so that the overall tax rate will still be lower, even with the passage of the VATRE.
- This is different from the Bond. Bond funds may only be used for facilities and assets, while the additional \$6 million in funds acquired through the passage of a VATRE would impact the Maintenance & Operations revenue, which funds teacher and staff compensation and day-to-day district operations.

• Funds acquired through the three-cent increase from the VATRE are not subject to recapture. VII. **REPORTS OF THE SUPERINTENDENT**

A. GCISD Balanced Scorecard Priority Report

Kelly Mires presented information on Priority 2, Faculty and Staff Recruitment, Retention and Capacity-Building related to exit interviews. She shared the purpose of exit interviews, the number of exit interviews, categories for resignations, and feedback received. Dave Denning provided an update on recruitment and hiring for the 2024-25 school year. Dr. Lisa Pedevilla presented information on professional development. She shared information on the professional learning that took place for staff prior to the first day of school. She shared data on the results from the new employee welcome survey and data from surveys from every professional development session. She also shared professional learning next steps.

Questions and comments took place.

B. Act on Donation from GCISD Special Athletics Booster Club

Dr. Schnautz shared information regarding the intended use and timeframe of the donation.

Move for the Board of Trustees to accept the donation of \$10,000 from the GCISD Special Athletics Booster Club to the GCISD Special Olympics for the 2024-2025 school year.

This motion was made by Tammy Nakamura and seconded by A.J. Pontillo.

Comments took place.

Motion passed 7-0.

C. Act on the Texas Association of School Boards Policy Update 123, Affecting Local Policies

Paula Barbaroux shared the recommendations are based on the regular and special sessions of the 88th legislative session.

Move for the Board of Trustees to add, revise, or delete local policies as recommended and according to the Instruction Sheet for Localized Policy Manual Update 123, except for Board Policy EFB(LOCAL).

This motion was made by A.J. Pontillo and seconded by Kathy Florence Spradley.

Motion passed 7-0.

D. Act on Board Policy EFB(LOCAL), Library Materials.

Dr. Schnautz shared the proposed revisions are due to changes to Texas Education Code and Texas Administrative Code.

Move for the Board of Trustees to revise and update Board Policy EFB(LOCAL), as presented.

This motion was made by Kathy Florence Spradley and seconded by Mary Humphrey. Questions and comments took place.

Motion passed 7-0.

E. Act to Change the Allocation in the 2016 Bond for the Fiber Installation Project to Interactive Displays for Classrooms

Kyle Berger explained the reason for the allocation change.

Move for the Board of Trustees to approve changing the allocation in the 2016 Bond for the Fiber Installation Project to an allocation for classroom interactive displays and add the fiber installation project to the 2024 Bond Program funded from the interactive displays' allocation.

This motion was made by Tammy Nakamura and seconded by Kathy Florence Spradley.
