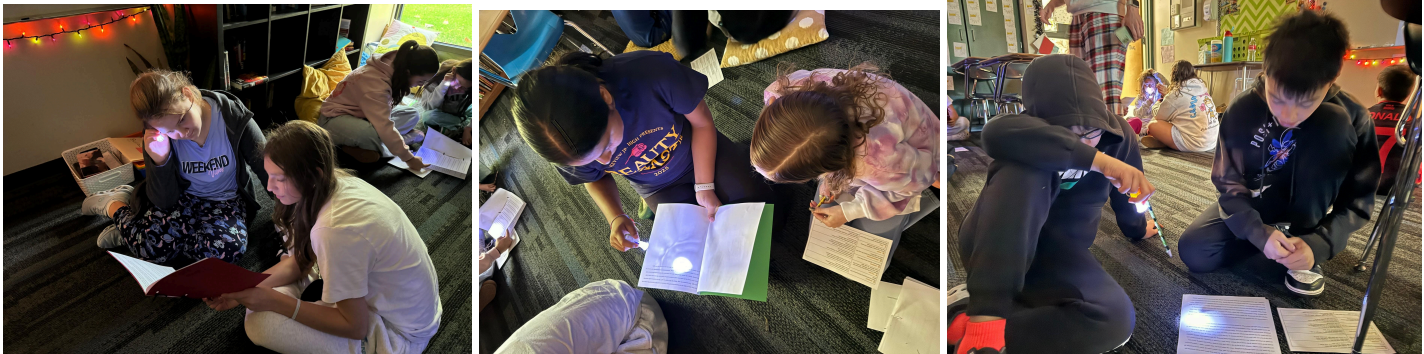
**November '25 Board Report**
