Detailed description of elementary reading program aligned to Science of Reading	The Piggott School District uses Benchmark Workshop for K-5 instruction and Wonders for grade 6 instruction that are aligned with the Science of Reading components. We use Lexia as the intervention for students that are needing extra assistance. For our dyslexia students use the Sonday System for intervention. All of these programs are state approved programs. PSD will provide on-site testing for virtual students using Dibels, Star, Encoding, and RAN. Parents will be contacted and given optional times to bring their student on campus to be tested. This testing will go through October 2021.
How will the teacher engage students in direct instruction in the Science of Reading?	PSD teachers that have these virtual students will zoom with the students to provide the necessary direct instruction for the Science of Reading components and Scarborough's Rope components.
How will teachers engage students in small group instruction at least 3 times a week for K-2?	PSD has three students that have chosen the virtual learning option this semester. These students' on campus teachers will provide small group instruction at a

	minimum of three days per week to involve the components of Scarborough's Rope and the Science of Reading. We will use web cameras and the students' parents will be given zoom link access for their students to zoom into their class during the small group instruction time. This instruction will be offered daily.
How will interventions be provided in K-6?	PSD provides students with login information for Lexia Core 5 and Lexia Power Up for personalized science of reading interventions. These programs will assign the students the recommended amount of time and areas that are in need of intervention. The ES principals and on site Edgenuity mentor will follow up to ensure intervention times are being met.
 What are the number of students per teacher per course and the grade level of the students? 	PSD is using Edgenuity Inc. to provide daily instruction to our 5 virtual students in grades K-6. Edgenuity's staff has a ratio of 1:50 per course.
