Summary:	Texas Senate Bill 546 (89th Legislative Session) mandates that all school buses in Texas be equipped with three-point seat belts by September 1, 2029. Additionally, the law requires school districts to report the number of belted buses and the cost to retrofit older buses in a public meeting. As part of the required estimated cost reporting, school districts will be able to participate in a grant opportunity related to seat belt installation. Details pertaining to this grant will be released in the future.
