Background:

The Marana Unified School District (MUSD) last adopted changes to the Class Participation and Various Fees Schedule on May 14, 2026.

This proposed change eliminates a Dual Enrollment fee associated with Pima Community College math courses. Recently, MUSD administration reflected with teachers on their desire to continue using an enhanced tool which added costs to the program. After the reflection, it was determined that teachers can deploy other teaching resources for similar results. Below is the recommended change.

- Removal of \$140 fee for Dual Enrollment Classes (Pima Community College- Math Courses)
