TOPIC: Approval of Limited Schools of Choice Program

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools District accept the recommendation of the superintendent to participate in Limited Schools of Choice under Section 105 c for the 2014-15 school year. Openings to include: up to ten (10) students at each grade K-4; up to five (5) students at each grade 5-6 for a total of 60 students.

RATIONALE:

Section 105c Limited Schools of Choice will bring additional revenue to the district and preserve programs essential to the students of Livonia Public Schools.
