The cafeteria served 6,257 breakfast meals and 7,011 lunch meals for the month of September. Some random facts we sold 805 ice cream products, 1,510 cookies, 876 bags of chips, 431 extra main entrees and 187 adult meals this month also.

We are awaiting the approval of November 13th to host the annual Thanksgiving Celebration with all hands-on deck- Custodial, Culinary Arts, NHS and the help of several substitutes. Last year we served approx. 1032 Thanksgiving meals to students, parents and staff. We will continue to add a full buffet line in the cub gym to help with the overflow and serving lines.

We have completed approx. 8-9 weeks of breakfast in the classroom. We are sending 132 meals every day. We are always trying new food and food combinations. Some do better than other for instance the kids seem to like fresh fruit over a fruit cup.

So far, we have had a few problems with equipment such as the sinks leaking and the ice machine not working. Hopefully we will get those repaired quickly.

I am constantly amazed that I get to work along side 6 amazing women who come to work joyous and ready to serve the children at school.
