- 1. Double Science @ 7th grade with FLEXIBLE criteria as of 2012-13; block 1 must teach 100% 7th grade science TEKS: Science Interventions, block 2, with enhanced laboratory activities on 6th and 8th TEKS weaknesses
- 2. Double Science @ 8th grade with **FLEXIBLE** criteria as of 2012-13; block 1 must teach 100% 8th grade science TEKS: Science Interventions, block 2, with enhanced laboratory activities on 6th 8th TEKS weaknesses
- 3. Spanish I discontinued; replaced with Languages Other Than English Level III / Spanish 8th Grade (03443200- PEIMS)
- 4. ELA/R @ 8th grade by criteria; when a student takes ELAR instead of GT English and GT Reading, it would have no impact as long as student is enrolled in Project Design I, II, or III (Texas Performance Standards Project) or English College Academic Readiness (paired to ELAR).
- 5. When meeting criteria for ELA/R, 8th student will be paired with English College Academic Readiness--E/CAR

#### Middle School Course Placement Criteria

Algebra I: Students with a 5th grade TAKS scale score range between 738-893; and 6th grade TAKS range between 783-944

ELA/R: Students who in grade 6 met commended performance in TAKS reading AND in grade 4 met commended performance in TAKS reading & writing

<u>Science Interventions Gr. 7 and 8</u>: Students with a 5th grade TAKS science score below a 2200 scale; enrollment *flexibility* depending on space availability.
