Welcome back from Thanksgiving Break,

Hopefully everyone had time over the break to spend with family and friends. We have just concluded our 1<sup>st</sup> Trimester and will have our first round of parent/teacher conferences on December 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>. This will give you and the teachers, time to sit down and discuss your child academically, behaviorally, and socially. The teachers and assistants have been working night and day to provide your child with quality instruction in the classroom based on their individual needs. This year with 90 minutes of instruction designated to math and reading at each grade level, students have been making dramatic academic gains. Every grade level has been working on 60 minutes of whole group instruction in math and reading each day, after this students move to small groups where they get differentiated instruction based on their needs. This has provided time for students to work on their own skill needs, while not missing any content at their grade level.

Illinois Valley, Lorna Byrne, Evergreen:

In the event of adverse weather conditions parents are advised to tune in to Radio Stations KRWQ, KAJQ, KLDK, KBOY and TV Stations KOB1 (5), KDRV (12), KTVL (10) or the Three Rivers School District Web Page ([www.threerivers.k12.or.us](http://www.threerivers.k12.or.us)) for information on school bus schedules, delays or closures.

Sometimes weather conditions leave some roads blocked or unsafe to travel but school is still being held. Under these circumstances "straight line routes" will be run. This is the information you will get on the web page or radio/TV stations.

When straight line routes are run the roads affected are listed below.

If you live on one of the roads the buses cannot travel, you may bring your student to the nearest intersection of the main road traveled. This will also be the stop for the afternoon drop off.
