Monday, April 14, 2014-Day 1:

a.m. Depart from a local airport for Nashville, TN.

Approx. time of arrival at airport in Tennessee.

A local bus will pick up group.

We will provide transportation for the 3 days of your trip, as needed.

p.m. Visit Opry Mills, located on the existing Opryland site, Opry Mills is home

to over 200 retailers, entertainment venues, and restaurants. Time for shopping at Tennessee's home for Shoppertainment, also the location of The **Gibson Bluegrass Showcase**, where your group can watch as skilled

craftsmen make mandolins, banjos, and guitars.

Hours 10 am - 9:30 pm Monday - Saturday and 11 am - 7 pm Sunday.

Option: Self-guided Tour of the Ryman Auditorium, the original home of the

Grand Ole Opry is an additional \$18 per person.

4:00 p.m. Arrive at a local hotel.

Time to check into the hotel and freshen up.

7:00 p.m. **Dinner at a local restaurant.**

8:30 p.m. Return to the hotel to enjoy the hotel facilities.

Tuesday, April 15, 2014-Day 2:

8:00 a.m. Continental Breakfast in the Hotel.

9:00 a.m. **Depart for Vanderbilt University**, subject to availability.

10:00 a.m. 2 hr. clinic for the Chorus, subject to availability and scheduling.

12 noon Lunch on your own.

1:30 p.m. Time for sightseeing in "Music Row" in downtown Nashville. Music Row

came together in the 1950's as Nashville became a central part of the recording industry. It grew to a group of recording studios in Music Square including RCA's Studio B, Sony Music, MCA Studios, United

Artists Tower, Starstruck Studios, and more.



3:00 p.m. Visit The Parthenon, Nashville, TN, 2 mi. w. on West End Ave. in the

middle of Centennial Park. The Parthenon is a full-size replica of the Parthenon on the Acropolis in Athens, Greece. The only such replica in the

world, the Nashville Parthenon is the home of the city of Nashville's

permanent art collections. Included within the Parthenon is a 42-foot-high

sculpture of Athena, the goddess of wisdom. Visit the gift shop.

NOTE: The Parthenon is closed Sundays and Mondays. The tour takes approx. 1 hour and

a maximum of 40 students and 3-6 chaperones are admitted at a time. The

remainder of the group must wait outside and can walk around Centennial Park.

OPTION: Your group can perform in Centennial Park, subject to park approval.

Enjoy the Park afterward.

p.m. Dinner at a local restaurant.

7:30 p.m. Show at the Grand Ole Opry (level 3 seating), subject to availability. A

music variety show, the Grand Ole Opry celebrates the many styles of music within the umbrella category of country, a tribute to the rich legacy

of music that has come from Nashville and the South.

Option: Level 2 seating is an additional \$15 per person.

9:30 p.m. Return to the hotel.

Wednesday, April 16, 2014-Day 3:

8:00 a.m. Continental Breakfast in the Hotel.

9:00 am Depart for Historic Studio B. 10:00 a.m. You will be Stars For A Day.

There will be a 20 minute introductory tour followed by a 45 minute recording session in RCA's **Historic Studio B**, where much of Nashville's

sound got its start.

Note: <u>Large groups will have separate recording sessions (maximum 60 people per session)</u>. While each group is recording, the other groups will be at the Hall of Fame. Each group that records receives 2 master recordings and will be able to purchase additional albums for \$6 apiece.

Please note, additional albums must be ordered in advance.

p.m. Admission to the Country Music Hall of Fame.

Option: An Education program at the Country Music Hall of Fame is an

additional \$10 per person, subject to availability.

1. Stories with the songwriter - there is no maximum number of people.

2. Sharing songs and writing with the songwriter - there is a maximum of 50

people.



Option:

BBQ Buffet Lunch at the Wildhorse Saloon is an additional \$50 per person, subject to availability. Lunch includes: House salad, Hickory smoked pulled pork, bourbon baked beans, cole slaw, assorted dinner rolls, fruit cobbler, coffee and tea (menu subject to changes)

Your recording will be played as you eat.

Following your lunch, you can choose to have a line-dancing lesson at

the saloon, which is included in the cost.

The price is \$669.00 per person based on minimum 14 students, 2 paying adults and 2 complimentary chaperones.

If you have less than 16 students/paying adults, the cost of the trip will go up.

This price is based on 6 rooms (4 rooms for the 14 students, 1 room for the 2 paying adults and 1 room for the 2 complimentary chaperones.

Airline tickets are additional \$455 - \$575 per ticket plus \$20 per ticket service charge, subject to taxes availability at the time of booking.

There are no complimentary airline tickets for the chaperones.

These airfares are based out of a large airport.

There will be a supplemental charge for a smaller airport closer to your school.

Note: Price may go up slightly due to the possible increase of busing/fuel costs.

Prices for Holiday weeks may vary slightly.

Extra hotel security can be arranged for additional \$25 - \$40 per hour per guard and we must be informed at least 30 days prior.
