August Board Report

Building level meetings:

The beginning of the year has been filled with medical 504 meetings and critical IEP meetings. Students with severe medical needs must have meetings at the beginning of the school year in order to update protocols and health information. Students with 504 plans for diabetes, severe allergies, etc. all require meetings to prepare staff for medical needs.

Students moving into the district with IEP's also require meetings in order to ensure we are providing the proper services for them. This year, WHS and WJHS have had a total of 11 students that transferred in with either a 504 or IEP.

Staff trainings for the district cardiac arrest plans and emergency undesignated medication all must occur prior to students in our buildings, along with emergency evacuation trainings for students that cannot use stairs due to physical limitations.

Building level administration and staff have been fantastic to work with despite their busy schedules. They have all prioritized the trainings and have contributed to discussions regarding the best ways to keep our students and staff safe in our buildings.
