Background Information:

Belton ISD seeks Board approval for charters when establishing stakeholder advisory groups, including the commission of a Citizens Bond Advisory Committee, to officially authorize their purpose, process, and roles while enhancing community transparency. Guided by the District's mission to align with its *Destination 2031 Strategic Plan*, this charter directs the District's focus to stewardship, facility preservation, and safety. Serving as an objective community voice, committee members evaluate demographic, facility, and financial data to potentially build a consensus-based recommendation package. Final authority rests with the Board of Trustees to determine if a bond election will be called.
