Committee Purpose & Intended Outcomes

- **Review:** Examine demographic, growth trends, facility assessment, long-range planning, and financial data.
- **Evaluate:** Analyze gathered data and insights from facility tours.
- **Collaborate:** Develop fiscally responsible recommendations to address district needs.



Roles & Responsibilities

- **Belton ISD Bond Committee:** Balance student needs with taxpayer interests, attend meetings, and provide consensus-based recommendations.
- **Administrative Support:** Provide information and answers to address committee questions and concerns.
- **Superintendent:** Work with the committee to refine recommendations and ensure project feasibility before Board review.
- **Board of Trustees:** Nominate committee members, monitor progress, review final proposals, and authorize any bond elections.



Proposition Scope & Statutory Boundaries

To maintain focus on the core facility priorities outlined in this charter and ensure full alignment with state statute, the committee's scope of study and final recommendations are strictly restricted to a **single General-Purpose Bond Measure** (Proposition A).
