## 203.2 ORDER OF THE REGULAR SCHOOL BOARD MEETING

## I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to ensure consistency in the order of business at regular school board meetings.

## II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

It is the policy of the school board to consider matters that come before it in a consistent and orderly manner.

## III. ORDER

- A. The school board shall conduct an orderly school board meeting. The school board will, at all regular school board meetings, follow an agenda order similar to:
  - 1. Call to order.
  - 2. Roll call of attendance.
  - 3. Approval of the agenda.
  - 4. Approval of the consent agenda.
  - 5. Building presentation/school board recognition.
  - 6. Public comment.
  - 7. Report from student representatives.
  - 8. Approval of minutes.
  - 9. Discussion/Information items.
  - 10. Action items.
  - 11. School board committee reports.
  - 12. Superintendent's report.
  - 13. Adjournment.
- B. The school board may depart from the order of business with the consent of the majority of members present.
