- 3. Mini-Grant Dennis reports we have a couple handed in, but still have until October 1 to receive.
- 4. Publicity Dr. Lett estimated the cost to the PEF for the initial and continued funding of the 1 to 1 initiative program.
 - a. 42 Full participants @ \$80/unit, 1 Yr. = \$3,360, 3 Yr. = \$10,800
 - b. 63 Partial participants @ \$40/unit, 1 Yr. = \$2,520, 3 Yr. = \$7,560
 - c. PEF Support. 1 Yr. = \$4,000 to \$12,000, 3 Yr. = \$12,000
 - d. Up Front District, 1 Yr. = 16,800, 3 Yr. = 5,040
 - i. 105 Google Chrome books @ \$239/unit = \$\$25,095
 - ii. 15 Teach units @ \$239/unit = \$3,585
 - iii. 120 Management support fee @ \$30/unit = \$3,600
 - iv. 120 Backpack sleeves @ \$20/unit = \$2,400
