## TITLE ONE

B. If the teacher is teaching under an emergency status for which state licensing requirements have been waved.

C. The type of college degree and major of the teacher and the field of discipline for any graduate degrees and certificates.

D. If your child is receiving Title One services from Para-professionals and, if so, his/her qualification.

## Education of All Disabled

### Children/Young Adults

Public Law 105.17 know as I.D.E.A.

(Individualized Disability Education Act) requires that school districts provide a free and appropriate education to all disabled children/young adults ages 0 to 21.

**Thank you for your understanding and cooperation. Remember to pick up the requested assignment and be sure your child turns their assignment in when they return to school.**

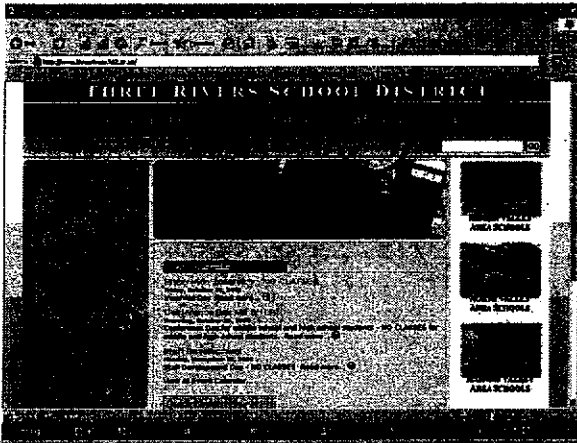
