TITLE ONE


A. If the teacher has met state licensing requirements for the grade level and subjects in which the teacher is providing instruction.

B. If the teacher is teaching under an emergency status for which state licensing requirements have been waved.

C. The type of college degree and major of the teacher and the field of discipline for any graduate degrees and certificates.

D. If your child is receiving Title One services from Para-professionals and, if so, his/her qualification.


Education of All Disabled Children/Young Adults

Public Law 105.17 know as I.D.E.A.

(Individualized Disability Education Act) requires that school districts provide a free and appropriate education to all disabled children/young adults ages 0 to 21.

Three Rivers School District requests the identification of any disabled children/young adults between the ages of 0 to 21, who are not enrolled or currently being served by the district school.

If you know of any disabled children/young adults between the ages of 1 to 21 who are not receiving educational services, please call the Special Education Department of the Three Rivers School District. The phone number is 862-3111.

If you call in the morning before 8:30 a.m., the work will be ready for you after 2:35 p.m. that afternoon. If you call <u>later than 8:30 a.m. in the morning</u>, the assignments will be ready the following morning.


Thank you for your understanding and cooperation. Remember to <u>pick up</u> the requested assignment and be sure your child turns their assignment in when they return to school.




