SUBJECT:

Proposed removal of Asbestos Containing Material (ACM) from Lincoln and

Washington Elementary Schools.

The following quotation is submitted per your request for <u>removal</u> of ACM (Asbestos Containing Material) located at above referenced subject.

Following all applicable Federal, State and Local Regulations, Triple A Asbestos Services, Inc., Illinois Licensed Contractor IDPH Number 500-0578, will supply IDPH licensed, skilled workers and supervisor(s), wages, paid at Prevailing Rate of Christian County; materials, equipment; provide proper insurances including general liability, asbestos and pollution, workman compensation and auto; proper paperwork; manifest, haul and disposal of waste to an authorized landfill. Upon completion of the project, all paperwork will be forwarded to the owner for permanent record retention.

#### Owner's Responsibilities:

The owner is responsible for ensuring all movable items in the work area are removed prior to the commencement of the project.

This project is bid under NESHAP (National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants) and OSHA Standards, and applicable IDPH (Illinois Department of Public Health) Regulations for Commercial and Public Buildings (non-AHERA –non-school projects).

## Project Overview for Washington Elementary School:

- The projects entail the construction of a negative pressure enclosure system, partial demolition of the boiler system, and removal of asbestos-containing materials, including:
  - 6,410 sq. ft. of 2' x 4' ceiling tiles in 6 classrooms, 5 corridors, and 2 stairwells.
  - 7,412 sq. ft. of 9" x 9" floor tile and associated black cutback mastic throughout.
  - 1,050 sq. ft. of aircell insulation board from the walls and ceiling of the boiler.



## Project Overview for Lincoln Elementary School:

- The projects entail the construction of a negative pressure enclosure system, partial demolition of the boiler system, and removal of asbestos-containing materials, including:
  - 7,895 sq. ft. of 9" x 9" floor tile and associated black cutback mastic throughout.
  - 1,050 sq. ft. of aircell insulation board from the walls and ceiling of the boiler.

## Site Assessment and Planning:

- Conduct an initial site assessment to identify all work areas and materials requiring removal.
- Develop a detailed project plan, including safety protocols and timelines.

#### Site Preparation:

- Secure the work area to prevent unauthorized access and ensure safety.
- o Install necessary barriers, barricade tape, and signage around the designated area.

#### Containment Setup:

- Construct a Three-Stage Wet Decontamination System and a Two-Stage Waste Loadout System for Worker and Equipment Decontamination.
- Install critical barriers utilizing polyethylene sheeting and duct tape at all openings and access points to prevent fiber release during operations.
- Utilize Ground Fault Circuit Interrupters (GFCI) for all electrical outlets and equipment to prevent electrical hazards.
- o Installing appropriate HEPA filtration units to maintain negative pressure.

#### Asbestos Abatement Procedures:

- Floor Tile/Ceiling Tile/Boiler Insulation Removal:
  - Utilize wet/gross removal methods to minimize dust and fiber release during the removal process.

## Black Mastic Removal:

 Apply a low/no odor mastic remover to safely dissolve and remove the black cutback mastic from the substrate.

#### Debris Management:

- Properly place all debris in sealed leak tight containers and label all asbestos-containing waste for disposal.
- Store all asbestos waste in a designated enclosed dumpster that is locked and secured.

#### Post Abatement Cleaning:

- o Perform a thorough inspection to confirm the removal of all asbestos-containing materials.
- Execute a final clean of the work area utilizing wet wipe and HEPA vacuum methods.


