2. Background:

The state's purchasing requirements specify that any purchase(s) \$50,000 or more (including in the aggregate) must be competitively procured CH (Legal)(Local).

3. Process:

The district received a Cybersecurity Pilot grant. As part of the grant, the district issued a RFP, in conjunction with ESC12 and USAC. The district received four responses. After evaluating the responses, it was determined that StackLynk was the best option for the district. The district will be responsible for 10% out of pocket of the funding request.

The contract will be renewed annually for two additional years.

\$2,317.60 (\$23,176.00 with \$20,858.40 being reimbursed back to the district)
