New Denton High School Administrative Furniture Purchase
September 14, 2021

SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of the quotes from Plano Office Supply in the amount of \$399,913.95 for administrative furniture for the new Denton High School.

BOARD GOAL:

Growth & Management – Demonstrate effective and efficient management of district resources

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

The Board called for the 2018 bond election with the recommendation by the Bond Committee. On May 5, 2018, the bond was approved by the voters of Denton ISD.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This purchase will provide administrative furniture for the newly constructed Denton High School campus that is scheduled to be turned over to the District April 2022. The quoted list of furniture was reviewed and accepted by Joel Hays, Principal, Denton High School.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

The administrative furniture will be purchased from Plano Office Supply through a Texas Local Governmental Purchasing Cooperative OMNIA contract award. This purchase is being brought for approval in accordance with the District's CH (local) policy.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The cost will be borne through the 2018 Bond Authorization.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

The approval of this purchase will allow the District to order and have the administrative furniture installed once the District receives temporary certificate of occupancy of the building.

SUPERINTENDENT'S RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the quotes from Plano Office Supply in the amount of \$399,913.95 for administrative furniture for the new Denton High School be approved.
