• The Rangerettes defended their Heart O'Lakes Kick Championship this past weekend in Pelican Rapids. That gives them first place finishes in all three competitions they have competed in so far this season. This weekend they have one of the toughest and biggest invitationals of the season at BOLD High School. The following week they will be at an exclusive invite only meet in Holdingford.

### Hockey

The Girls Northern Lakes team are currently 3-5 on the season. They won their first contest 3-2 over AA Sartell/Sauk Rapids. The #9 Class A ranked Boys Northern Lakes team are 4-1 so far on the season with its only loss coming to #19 AA ranked Bemidji. They will play their first game at the Hallett Center on Saturday, January 4th.
