Background Information:

In accordance with Board Policy CDC (Local), the Board of Trustees must accept any bequest
or gift of money or property on behalf of the District if the value of the gift is \$20,000 or more.
 To be acceptable, a gift must have a purpose consistent with District goals and objectives.

Administrative Considerations:

- A#1 Air, a valued industry partner of Keller ISD, proposes to donate 200 HVAC motors to the KCAL HVAC Program. The motors are new, but not able to be used by the company, so they would like to donate them for student hands-on learning labs. The estimated value of the motors is \$60,000.
- The donor understands that the donation will become the property of Keller ISD and will be under the authority of the Superintendent in accordance with Board policy and administrative rules and regulations
