AGENDA ITEM:

Discuss and consider granting permission to administration to apply to the Texas Education Agency for a waiver related to students taking dual credit at Institutions of Higher Education

Districts can request a waiver for the State's 75,600 minute calendar requirement if district students are taking dual credit courses at an Institution of Higher Education (IHE) with a calendar of fewer than 75,600 minutes, including intermissions and recesses.

Galveston ISD is applying on behalf of dual credit students who complete courses early because the Higher Education Calendar is shorter than the school district calendar. The waiver will enable the District to receive attendance funding.

RECOMMENDATION:

I move that the administration apply to TEA for a waiver related to students taking dual credit courses at Institutions of Higher Education with Calendars of Fewer than 75,600 minutes.
