You are hereby notified that at the regular meeting of the School Board of Independent School District No. 508 held on April 21, 2025, a resolution was adopted by a majority roll call vote to not renew your contract effective at the end of the current school year. Said action of the board is taken pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 122A.40, Subdivision 5.

You may officially request that the school board give its reasons for the non-renewal of your teaching contract. If requested, we will provide a written statement of the reason within ten days of receiving your request. For your information, however, this action is taken due to requirements for posting for positions where Teachers with an Out of Field Permission teach in a field outside the field of the license held.
