

Consider Approval of the 2026-2027 Purchase from College Board

1. Background:

College Board is a not-for-profit organization that helps prepare students for a successful transition to college through programs and services in college readiness and college success - including the PSAT, SAT and the Advanced Placement Program. The SAT is an admission test administered by the College Board and is widely accepted by U.S. colleges and universities for admission. The College Board will service all of our students from 9th to 12th grade.

2. Process:

The College Board contract and purchase will serve Southwest High School, Southwest Legacy High School, and CAST STEM High School. College Board owns and delivers its national standardized tests to students to include materials for students, materials for participating schools, reports for districts and PSAT/SAT practice tools.

3. Fiscal Impact:

The total cost of College Board will not exceed \$150,000 from September 1, 2026 and will expire on June 30, 2027. CCMR funds will be used to purchase College Board..
