

Consider approval of the 2026-2027 Student Code of Conduct.

1. Background:

The 2026-2027 Student Code of Conduct provides information regarding the expectations for students' behavior and consequences for misconduct. The Student Code of Conduct governs all behavior at school, at school-sponsored and school-related activities, and during school-sponsored travel. The Student Code of Conduct governs some designated behavior occurring within 300 feet of school property, some designated behaviors occurring off campus, and any school-related misconduct regardless of time or location. Some changes in this year's Student Code of Conduct include an update to address uses of artificial intelligence in student misconduct and in academic work for school; clarity regarding in-school and out-of-school suspensions; and the addition of examples of student conduct related to school violence.

The SWISD Student Code of Conduct is developed using Walsh Gallegos for consultation and the Texas Association of School Boards (TASB) Model.
