Our focus on improvement of instruction...

- Employed 2 part time ELA intervention tutors to work with students with disabilities
- Implemented on site PD in ELA for our general education and inclusion teachers
- Continued to focus on intentional writing and reading in all classes
- Provided additional training in writing to teachers in all areas to assist them in effectively implementing writing in all classes
- Required all teachers to have focused, data driven small group interventions during RTI which were monitored through classroom observations
- Bi-weekly PLC meetings focused on student data using common assessment results, benchmark results, and standards based test results
- ELA general education and inclusion teachers were brought in to co-plan this summer using the new district adopted middle school ELA curriculum

Student focus.....

- Offered additional after school tutoring for students with disabilities
- Students participated in data chats throughout the school year with their teachers, and all MP 25 students participated in additional data chats with Mrs. Tanner.
- Implemented positive office referrals and “Hornet Bucks” as a motivational tool for students in an effort to encourage our unmotivated students to always do their best
