1. Is there an existing 2018-2019 CIS-Project Access SDA? If so where is it available for review?

Yes, an SDA is available for the months of April 2019 - August 2019 as this was a new service that was secured to assist with the current mental health needs. During the CIS review if so desired.

2. What services does the proposed 2019-2020 CIS-Project Access SDA provide that the proposed 2019-2020 CIS-SA SDA does not?

CIS-Project Access addresses the mental health needs with clinical case worker available to students.

3. Why is the proposed 2019-2020 CIS-Project Access SDA required?

To meet the high demand/counseling needs of students with mental health issues.

4. Why do the proposed 2019-2020 CIS-Project Access SDA and the proposed 2019-2020 CIS-SA SDA have different Funding Budget Codes?

Project Access is paid with federal funds -Title 4.

5. Why is the term date for the proposed 2019-2020 CIS-Project Access SDA different from the proposed 2019-2020 CIS-SA SDA?

The SDA differs because Project Access will provide one clinical case worker that services all district schools using Federal funds. The CIS-SA SDA covers the cost of 15 staff using Local funds.
