

COOPERATION WITH OTHER DISTRICTS FOR INSTRUCTION

It is the policy of the Board to seek for ways to improve instructional services to students as well as more efficient or economical ways of providing services through cooperation with other school districts.

Cooperation may include but is not intended to be limited to participation through "joint agreements" with neighboring districts for special education and vocational education. Agreements obligating the District shall be reviewed annually.

All students of the District shall be considered eligible for the cooperative services available to the District for which they qualify under the objective standards necessary for effective instruction.

The District shall make its own determination of graduation requirements for students in cooperative programs, applying the same general criteria to programs and courses offered cooperatively as to those under direct control of the District.
