Recommendation:

United ISD is committed to providing a safe and secure learning environment for all students and staff. As such, the District recently completed an annual review of its Multi-hazard Emergency Operations Plan (EOP).

United ISD acknowledges that parents and community members are likely very interested in the details of the plan; however, it is in the best interest of the students that the District does not share this information to the broader public as it could lead to compromising important campus security information. Specific details have been discussed with the School Safety and Security Committee, which convened in executive session on July 29, 2026, and will also be discussed in the Board's executive session.

It is recommended that the Board take possible action regarding the annual review of the District Multi-hazard Emergency Operations Plan (EOP).

Rationale:

Pursuant to CKC (LEGAL), each district shall adopt and implement a multi-hazard emergency operations plan for use in the district's facilities. The plan must address prevention, mitigation, preparedness, response, and recovery as defined by Texas School Safety Center in conjunction with the governor's office of homeland security and the commissioner.
