Recommendation:

United ISD is committed to providing a safe and secure learning environment for all students and staff. As such, the District recently completed its three-year safety and security audit of District facilities.

United ISD acknowledges that parents and community members are likely very interested in the details of the report; however, it is in the best interest of the students that the District does not share this information to the broader public as it could lead to compromising important campus security information. Specific details will be discussed in the Board's executive session.

It is recommended that the Board take possible action regarding the Safety and Security Audit Final Report and the District Audit Survey, Audit Cycle 2023-2026.

Rationale:

Pursuant to CKA (LEGAL), at least once every three years, each district shall conduct a safety and security audit of the district's facilities that includes a security review for each district facility. A district shall report the results of the safety and security audit to the board and the Texas School Safety Center.
