Re: Athletic Director Report February, 2015

Winter sports seasons are entering crunch time. As the girls' basketball teams enter district tournament play our boys' basketball and wrestling teams are concluding their conference competition in preparation for district tournaments.

Girls' Basketball- The program is well represented entering the district tournaments. The Varsity enters the tournament as the #2 seed behind Fruitland and with a win in its first game of the tournament would punch their ticket to the state tournament for a 3rd straight season. The JV team enters the district tournament as the #2 seed as well, while the Frosh/Soph team enters as the #1 seed. Varsity tournament is Feb 4th, 5th, 10th, and 12th at TVCC while the lower level tournament is Feb 3rd, and 6th at Payette. State tournament is Feb 19th-21st at Skyview High School in Nampa.

Boys' basketball- Currently the boys sit; Varsity- 9-7, JV- 12-5, and Frosh/Soph- 9-6. This year's SRV conference is one of the more balanced and competitive group of teams in recent history. The battle for the district championship is up for grabs and the conclusion of the season should be exciting. Lower level tournament is Feb 16th, 18th and 20th in Emmett. Varsity district tournament is Feb 17th, 21st, 24th, and 26th at TVCC. State tournament is March 5th-7th at Meridian High School.

Wrestling- Currently 8-7 in duals and 2-1 in conference duals. We have had kids place 28 times in tournaments. We are looking forward to our February matches. Senior night is set for Feb. 10th and "Alumni Night" set for Feb. 13th. We are also looking forward to hosting SRV districts on the 21st. State Wrestling will take place 27th and 28th in Pocatello.

Cheer- The cheer team finished 1st place in their division in their last cheer competition on Jan 24th at Bishop Kelly High School. This was the first cheer competition for our girls this year.

Spring Sports- Spring sports practices will begin February 27th.

We currently have sold 10 ad positions for the football score board. There are 4 positions available for ad spots left.

I am continuing to meet with different members of the community regarding the softball facilities and ideas for improvement. Coach Larry Corta and Shane Brown have expressed the need for new diamond dust on the fields as well as the possibility of some new fencing.

Tennis courts need repair to two of the nets for the upcoming season. They also need replacement of one set of poles for one of the courts. We are waiting to hear exact costs. We are currently in communication with the city on how we plan on funding these replacements.
