#### Single Audit

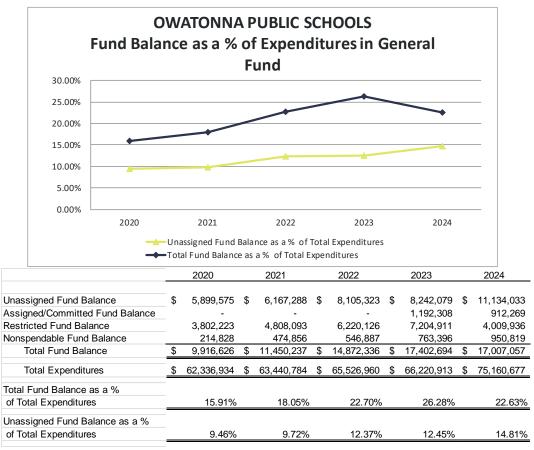
• <u>No findings</u> reported in regards to the requirements for the major federal programs tested (Child Nutrition and Special Education).

• No compliance issues were reported with respect to Minnesota Statutes.

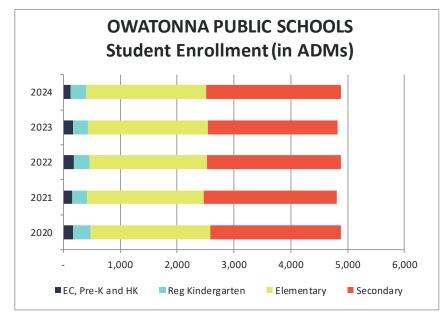


### Fund Balances of the General Fund





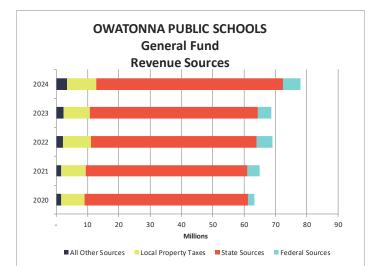

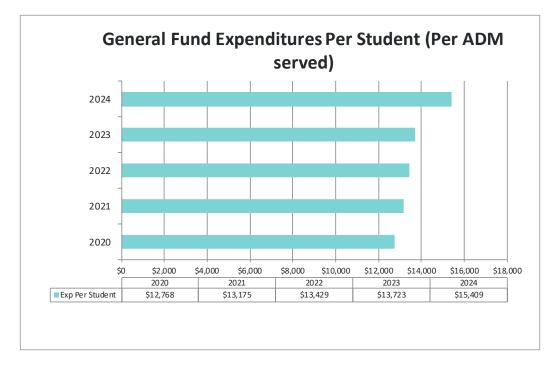

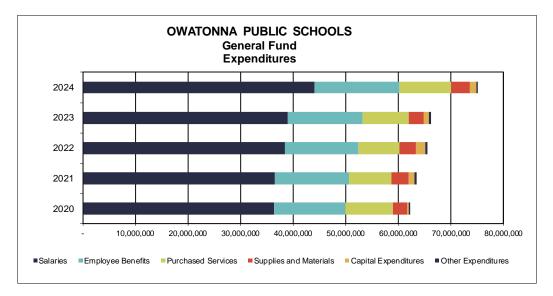
### General Fund – Expenditures Per ADM



In fiscal 2024, General Fund expenditures per student increased by 12.29% while total ADMs served increased 1.07%.



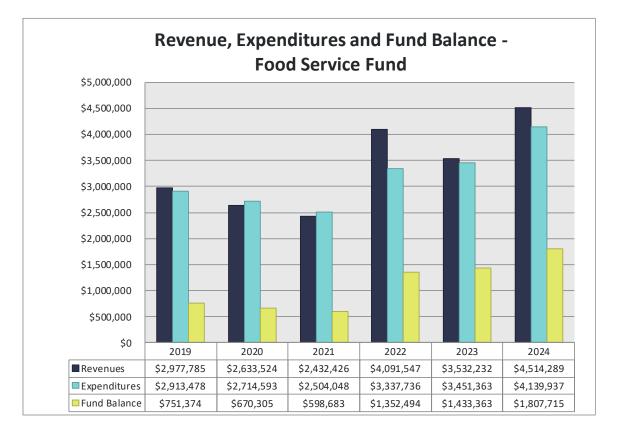

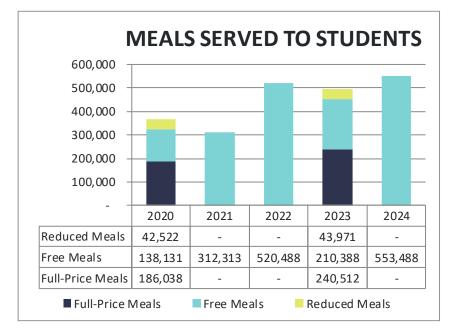

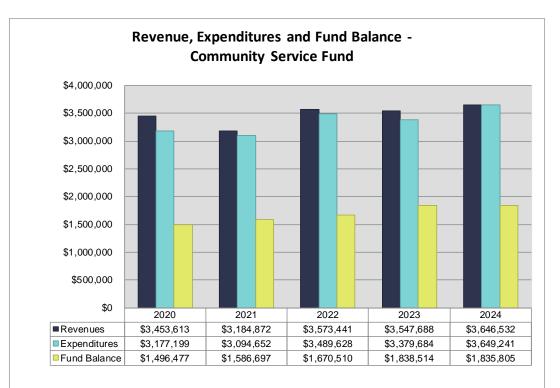

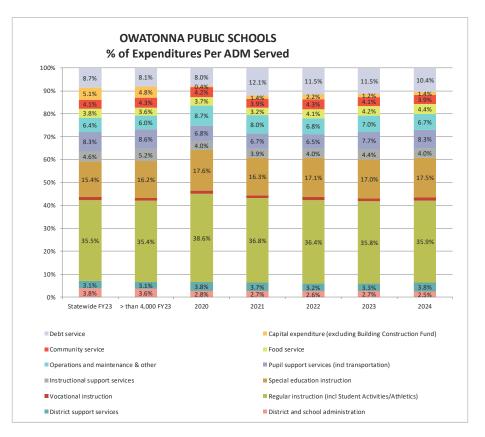


## Community Service Fund – Operating Results
