Noninstructional Operations - Emergency School Closures

The Superintendent is responsible for determining any emergency school closure due to extreme weather, hazardous travel, unsafe or unhealthy conditions, or for other emergencies.

The Board of Trustees, upon notification from the Superintendent of the emergency closure, may authorize shall certify the school closure due to extreme weather, hazardous travel, unsafe or unhealthy conditions, or for other emergencies, as may be determined by the Board. at the next board meeting.

Whenever an emergency school closure is declared, those schools affected shall cancel all before and after school activities or programs, extracurricular activities, and/or practices unless notified otherwise by the Superintendent. If practical, canceled activities may be rescheduled at a future date.
