Subject: Lunch Price Recommendation

The table below is a listing of the area schools and their 09-10 lunch prices. We are recommending that we increase our elementary lunch price \$.10 from \$1.65 to \$1.75. I am also recommending that we increase our secondary lunch price \$.10 from \$1.80 to \$1.90. We will continue to leave the milk price at \$.30. The recommendation is being made to continue to keep pace with increased food and labor costs. It has been two years since we have increased lunch prices. I am uncertain what the other districts listed may be recommending for prices for the 10-11 school year. As you will note, we are lower than any of the schools in the comparison and will continue to be as such even with the recommended increase.
