Professional Learning

District and Campus professional learning days occurred on January 5-6. Campuses opted for campus time in order to focus on campus specific professional learning needs and teacher planning time.

Curriculum

Instructional Materials Review and Approval (IMRA) Cycle 2026 will include a review of instructional K–5 supplemental reading language arts (RLA), in addition to the previously reviewed subjects and grade levels from IMRA Cycles 2024 and 2025.

A committee of K-5 teachers has been formed to begin the review process for a new K-5 reading language arts (RLA) curriculum. Only State Board of Education approved materials will be reviewed.

Assessment

District assessments were completed prior to Christmas break. Data from these assessments have been reviewed with campuses. Individualized plans are being developed to ensure each HISD Bobcat academically grows.

iReady screeners were completed for all 1st-8th grade students in reading and math prior to Christmas break. Data from these screeners will provide individualized intervention pathways for students.

Final December EOC results will be released to districts by January 15.
