

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION
OF WOODRIDGE SCHOOL DISTRICT #68
TO DECLARE UNNEEDED ITEMS AS SURPLUS**

Whereas, pursuant to the Illinois School Code, the Board of Education of Woodridge School District #68, DuPage County, Illinois (the "Board"), has the power and authority to declare items that are no longer needed for school district use as surplus; and

Whereas, pursuant to the Illinois Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, the Board has the power and authority to sell, trade, or donate items no longer needed for school purposes to other Illinois schools, school districts, or public bodies, and to other entities, as appropriate; and

Whereas, the Board has found and determined that the attached technology, furniture, miscellaneous equipment, and other surplus items are no longer needed for school purposes, and should therefore be declared as surplus and sold, donated, or disposed of for fair compensation, as appropriate; and

Whereas it is in the best interest of the school district to sell, donate, or dispose of said surplus items in order to free up storage space and receive appropriate and valuable compensation for any items having a fair market value, as applicable;

Now Therefore Be It Resolved, that the Board does hereby declare the items described above, and provided on the attached lists, as surplus and not needed for school operations, and does hereby direct the Assistant Superintendent for Business Services to sell, trade, donate and/or dispose of said surplus items in accordance with applicable State laws, and to deposit any net proceeds from the sale or trade-in thereon into the general funds of the School District.
