**APPROVE THE SECOND AMENDMENT FOR MATCH FUNDS TO  
INLAND SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA UNITED WAY  
FOR THE GUARANTEED INCOME PROGRAM PILOT GRANT FROM THE CALIFORNIA  
DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES  
FROM OCTOBER 25, 2023 – JUNE 30, 2026  
(CONTRACT NO. CF24136)  
[\$2,313,871.12 - PROP 10 FUNDS]**

**SUMMARY OF REQUEST**

Approve the Second Amendment to Contract No. CF24136 with Inland Southern California United Way to increase the not-to-exceed amount by \$105,271.12 (from \$2,208,600.00 to \$2,313,871.12) to cover required payment platform and related technology costs that were determined to be non-reimbursable, enabling the completion of the pilot through June 30, 2026.

**BACKGROUND**

Inland Southern California United Way (ISCUW) is implementing a Guaranteed Income (GI) Pilot Program in Riverside County, providing monthly stipends to pregnant individuals.

As part of the California Department of Social Services (CDSS)-funded GI pilot, grantees are required to use a standardized payment platform to support consistent program administration, participant payment delivery, and reporting. CDSS award guidance and eligibility determinations subsequently clarified that certain platform and related technology costs are not reimbursable under the CDSS funding, creating a funding gap for required implementation infrastructure.

The proposed Second Amendment increases Contract No. CF24136 by \$105,271.12 (from \$2,208,600.00 to \$2,313,871.12) to cover these required technology costs and enable the pilot to be completed and closed out through June 30, 2026 without reducing participant support or shifting required implementation costs to the contractor's unrestricted resources. These costs support program operations and closeout, including

payment administration and reporting requirements. The total contract amount remains within the Commission's originally approved not-to-exceed amount of \$2,500,000.

On September 11, 2024 (Action Item 24-28), the Commission approved an amendment to Contract No. CF24136 reducing the allocation to \$2,208,600 due to a revised CDSS award supporting 409 participants instead of 500.

On October 26, 2022 (Action Item 22-36), the Commission approved Proposition 10 match funds in an amount not to exceed \$2,500,000 for the GI Pilot.

## **RECOMMENDED ACTION**

That the Commission:

1. Approve the Second Amendment to Contract No. CF24136 with Inland Southern California United Way to increase the not-to-exceed amount by \$105,271.12, to \$2,313,871.12, for the Guaranteed Income Program Pilot, in essentially the same form as the Second Amendment attached hereto, and authorize the Executive Director to sign the Amendment on behalf of the Commission, subject to County Counsel approval as to form.
2. Authorize the Executive Director, based on the availability of fiscal funding, to sign amendments that exercise the options of executed Contract No. CF24136 on behalf of the Commission, including modifications to the statement of work that remain within the intent of the contract, without requiring further Commission action.

## **BUDGET IMPACT**

Adequate appropriation is included in the budget for Fiscal Year 2025/2026 (527980-25800-938001-92960).
