Rolling Ridge Park Path Project - Mayor King informed Council that the Park Board has reviewed and are proposing a new paved path that would run from the east side of Rolling Ridge Park along the west tree line to 20th St. NE, providing improved connectivity and access to the park. Preliminary cost estimates for the proposed path are not to exceed \$30,000.

Motion by Beyer, second Anderson to approve seeking bids for the path project. Unanimously approved.
