



Public Works Bi-Weekly Council Report June 6-4-26 thru 6-17-26

- We have reviewed the plans for the Rolling Ridge Restroom/Shelter with Nicole Pierson and the plans/specs should be done within a week for bidding.
- The catch basin on the Frontage Road by Maplebrook has been repaired.
- Fahrner has finished crack filling the streets that are going to be chip sealed and paths that they were able to access. They are going to return with different equipment in later July to get the remainder of the paths, the equipment they had brought was too large for some of the paths.
- We cleaned up the tree in Meadow Park South that blew during the spring storms. There were other trees in Maplebrook and Bear Cave Estates that were cleaned up.
- We have been meeting with businesses on the 2027 CIP and getting their concerns recorded.
- There were 5 different instances of people dumping garbage at our BCDS last Monday. Two ended up with illegal dumping tickets, as they were the only ones we could identify.
- The tennis/pickleball/basketball courts in Bear Cave have been washed, due to complaints about the dirt and staining on them.
- Potholes have been filled.
- There is a leak in one of the play features at our Aquatic Center. The fire hydrant feature leaks through the concrete while it is running. We shut down the fire hydrant for the season as we do not have the pool closed for repairs until fall.
- Tony put brakes in the tanker truck and we will be listing this on Public Surplus. The money from the sale will go back to the Fire Department since they have loaned us the truck.
- We are painting parking areas and crosswalks.
- We have mowed and cleaned up the ditch on the North side of Kwik Trip North and it's been added to the schedule to be mowed at least 3 times a year.
- The shelter (car port) for the dog park has been ordered and will be installed when it comes in.
- An Amazon semi hit light pole on Prime Dr. as it was turning around and we are working with them on this for payment.
- Chip sealing is scheduled for the week of July 9th.
