



## **Public Works Bi-Weekly Council Report 6-18-2026 thru 7-8-2026**

- Summerfest came and went with the weather allowing all festivities to take place. We always do a lot of preparations and clean up with this event.
- The path connecting Rolling Ridge Park to 20<sup>th</sup> St. NE. has been dug and rock placed. We have delayed the asphalt to allow the ground to firm up before they blacktop the path. Getting the big trucks in there after all of this rain will tear things up.
- We have been chasing a water main break in Maplebrook subdivision. It has been found and repaired. We are dealing with Electrolysis in that area and are having several breaks there. We had this happen on 10<sup>th</sup> Ave. and 3<sup>rd</sup> ST. NE. and ended up replacing all of the lines after we replaced almost all of the bells which are 20' apart from each other. I am getting some pricing on lining the pipe in this area and I will explain more at our Council meeting.
- The carport has come in for the dog park. Hoping to start putting that together and placing that next week. We have some unhappy patrons at the dog park recently as I had asked one person to please park in the parking area like all the other dog patrons. He says he is handicapped and doesn't know what he is hurting. I told him he is in a restricted area where we push up and burn the dump with lots of debris in the area. He told other patrons that I kicked him out (which is not true) which led to me getting a nasty message. He later rammed our barricades out there knocking them over and pushing them in.
- I will have an update on the design plans on the Rolling Ridge Restrooms from Nicole Pierson at the council meeting.
- The baseball program has asked to have nets put on top of the backstop at Meadow Park to catch some of the foul balls. I have told them that we prefer that they not. One of the poles is already bent and I don't think they are designed for that extra weight. We mowed some of the brush off and they are going to run some fence along the creek line there to catch the balls.
- The sidewalk and dirt work connecting Lapointe Dr. to 106 has been completed.
