



Public Works Bi-Weekly Council Report 7/9/26 thru 7/22/26

- Chip sealing of the Lake Florence area, Downunder parking lot, Subway parking lot, and the Nursing Home parking lot/alley has been completed. They will be in on July 28th to fog seal over the chip seal and then we will stripe the lots.
- When 2nd Avenue SW was constructed they apparently forgot to put a plug in the pipe and erosion eventually plugged the pipe. This caused the approach to Podeins back entrance to heave and bust up. We dug and plugged the pipe and have Nos Concrete lined up to pour the new approach on 7/27/26.
- The dog park shelter replacement has begun. The frame is up and we will have it tinned in the near future.
- We keep attempting to get the Rolling Ridge path extension compacted but it is still too soft to blacktop.
- Curb is scheduled to be replaced on 7/27/26 in the Maplebrook subdivision after the water main breaks there. We will prep for asphalt after the curb has cured for a week.
- Some complaints about the dog park fencing have been remedied. We patched some of fencing and pushed down some areas of fence that heaved from frost.
- Fencing was pushed down in Bear Cave softball complex. Balls were getting underneath the fence so the guys pushed the fence down.
- The railing in Peace Park was painted for the open house.

Between getting this ready for chip sealing and cleaning up afterwards in preparation or fog sealing, this has kept us busy.
