Summer School

Summer School 2014 supported 6 diverse classes for students ranging from Pre-school to grades 6. Our attendance record indicates that our average attendance rate was 90 students. One priority during summer school was the new program Move Over When Reading, designed to meet the academic challenges for 9 third grader students. This group targeted 9 students who tested in the falls far below category of AIMS. Mrs. Gonzales used various strategies to help student advance. Another group that was targeted for Summer School services was 107 English Language Learners, (ELL) in grades 1-5th. The teachers designed their curriculum to meet the needs of the ELL students. They reinforced language, writing, reading, and speaking skills. We also offered academic classes for students in grades 1-6. These classes focused on both math and reading. Apache Language classes also offered. Apache Language

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classes taught, history, language a variety of crafts for students to create and make. Extended services were made available for both Special Education students and Pre-school. Other programs that were housed at our facilities were: The Young Warriors Program, Save the Children and Pathways to Health.
